With another round of apologies if this message reaches you in error, let us inform you that Lowell GIRO Data Center remains offline after a campus-wide cybersecurity incident at UMass Lowell on June 14. We do observe the partial return of Internet services, such as UML e-mail and Zoom. However, it is unclear when GIRO data servers and web portals are reopened to public access.

GIRO ionosondes continue to buffer undelivered data; we do not expect data loss.

Very sorry for the inconvenience.

We hope to be back to normal operations soon.
