



# GIRO Web: Any moment now

Incoming real-time data streaming is restored

Good news: Incoming real-time data streams to GIRO from the ionosonde network have been restored. Data-providing observatories are about to catch up with their backlogs; 54 stations have already done so. As soon as the backlog is completed, we will start IRTAM reanalysis, and as soon as this is done, we will file a request to reopen our web portals ([giro.uml.edu](http://giro.uml.edu), etc.)

SAO Explorer will remain offline until we resolve the problem of remote access permission to DIDBase over Firebird SQL port 3050. It is not clear how this new security requirement will pan out for us.

Sorry for the inconvenience. Hope to be back in full operations soon.
